General Rules and Guidelines

- Entry forms must be completed and signed. The generic entry form enclosed in the premium may be used for any of the race meets. Phone/email entries will be accepted for the NAWRA, LGRA and NOTRA events, but entry fees must be paid and entry forms must be signed prior to inspection for each day's event.
- For NAWRA, LGRA and NOTRA, First Time Entered (FTE) hounds will be accepted but you **MUST** attach a **separate** photocopy of your dog's registration for each organization, and submit a one-time \$2.00 registration fee **per hound, per organization**. It is strongly recommended you pre-register your hounds in advance of the meet; for more information on pre-registration, please see each organization's website below.
- All hounds must be registered with the acceptable registries for each racing organization, and must be at least one (1) year of age, *with the exception* of the NAWRA meet, which has no age minimum and also offers puppy races for puppies aged 8-14 months. Because LGRA and NOTRA do not have any provision for running puppies, puppy races will only be offered for whippets entered in the NAWRA meet only, and puppy racers are not eligible for the Versatility award.
- All hounds must be qualified to race and participants must make every effort to properly box and race train hounds before entering them in competition. Box training will only be available at the meets as time and willing helpers permit. FTEs may be required to run a qualifying run with another dog before entries will be accepted.
- All racers will be boxed unless the race committee deems the boxes will not accommodate a breed in attendance. All hounds must wear racing muzzles and correctly colored and numbered jackets. Limited equipment is available to borrow. Please be considerate of your host clubs and fellow exhibitors, and return borrowed equipment promptly. Regular Stakes

*All hounds entering the Open, Veteran or Limited stakes for the first time must include a completed certification form or waiver **and** a copy of the hound's registration certificate with their entry. The requirement to include a copy of registration is waived for NGA Greyhounds.*

OPEN: Any eligible sighthound, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION: Any ASFA Field Champion.

VETERAN: Any eligible sighthound whose age is at least six years, except Irish Wolfhounds, whose age shall be at least five years, and Whippets, whose age shall be at least seven years.

LIMITED: Any eligible sighthound of a Limited or Provisional Stake breed that has met certification requirements.

SINGLES: Any eligible sighthound, including those disqualified from running in other stakes. No certification required. No ASFA points or placements toward titles awarded, and stake winner is not eligible for BIF.

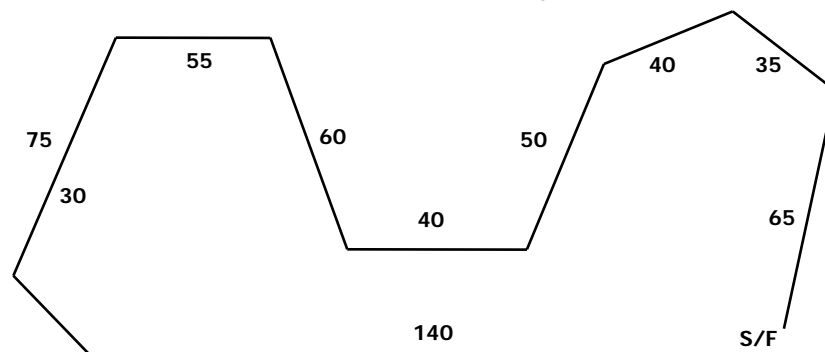
BEST IN FIELD will **NOT** be offered.

General Rules and Guidelines

All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial. Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused. Entry fee for hounds excused during inspection for bitches in season, lameness or breed disqualification shall be refunded. Substitutions allowed if submitted prior to close of entries. Spayed or neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered. Hound certifications will NOT be offered. Battery powered DRAG lure machine will be used. Lure will consist of white plastic bags. A \$5 penalty will be assessed for any loose hound on the trial site not competing in the course in progress. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the site. The Field Committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial. Please pick up after yourself and your dog(s); you are responsible for packing out your own garbage, including dog poop. *Persons exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct detrimental to NWSGA, WWWW, ASFA, any hound, or other person will be asked to leave the trial site and may be subject to further disciplinary action.*

Versatility Scoring

Special prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of the ASFA trial for the highest scoring hound in each breed entered in all four areas of competition:

Sprint Racing (NAWRA *or* LGRA)

and

Oval Racing (NOTRA)

and

Lure Coursing (ASFA)

and

Conformation Match

Any hound may be entered in any one event or combination of events, but only hounds that compete in all four areas of competition will be eligible for versatility awards.

The versatility awards will be determined by the following method:

- To be eligible, hounds must complete all events, without dismissal or disqualification, in all four events. Hounds that scratch from any event, for any reason, are not eligible for versatility awards.
- Each hound competing in either the NAWRA or the LGRA receives all NAWRA or LGRA meet points. (Whippets must compete as adults.)
- Each hound competing in the NOTRA receives all NOTRA meet points.
- Each hound competing in the ASFA trial receives 1 point for each dog defeated in its own stake. In addition, placements will be rewarded as follows: 1st place in each stake = 10 points, 2nd = 8 points, 3rd = 6 points, 4th = 4 points, NBQ = 2 points. Best of Breed will receive an additional 5 points.
- Each hound competing in the conformation match receives 1 point for each dog defeated in its own class. In addition, placements will be rewarded as follows: 1st place in each class = 10 points, 2nd = 8 points, 3rd = 6 points, 4th = 4 points. Best of Breed will receive an additional 5 points and Best Opposite Sex will receive an additional 3 points.
