At this time of year we must be very careful of the wet condition of the field and  
parking areas. Any ruts must be repaired when leaving. Make every effort to park  
wisely for your vehicle.

NWRRC will provide coffee and muffins in the morning.

Hot sandwiches will be provided for lunch. Please bring other potluck items to  
round out the meal. There will be electricity for crockpots.

### **Directions to the Field**

#### ***From I-90 Eastbound:***

- Take Exit 27 (Snoqualmie/Snoqualmie Falls)
- At the off-ramp stop sign go left, and continue down the hill (N Bend Way)
- Take the Snoqualmie-Snoqualmie Falls left-turn lane, following signs to  
Snoqualmie Falls, and turn left onto Meadowbrook Way
- Continue downhill past the Snoqualmie Hospital entrance
- At the traffic light at SR 202 (Milk Barn on left) continue straight; you will  
pass Mount Si High School on your left
- At the stop sign, turn right onto Park Street. Continue east on Park, past  
Snoqualmie Elementary School and Centennial Fields Park on your right
- Meadowbrook Farm begins here. The Interpretive Ctr bldg is on right in 1 mile.

#### ***From I-90 Westbound:***

- Coming from Snoqualmie Pass, take Exit 31 (North Bend) and turn right onto  
North Bend Boulevard
- Continue through the traffic lights (Outlet Shopping Mall on the left) and  
across the railroad tracks, through downtown North Bend
- Bear left as the road, now SR 202, turns and continues out of town, across a  
bridge. Past the bridge, turn right onto Boalch Avenue
- Continue on Boalch (funeral home on right, then Encompass on left) across a  
small bridge
- Immediately after the small bridge, the Interpretive Ctr bldg is on the left

**ELIGIBLE BREEDS:** Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azwakh, Basenjis,  
Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh  
Hounds, Portugese Podengos, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds,  
Sloughis, Thai Ridgebacks and Whippets that are one year of age or older, that have  
been registered with The American Kennel Club a foreign have been granted an  
Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and  
trials. Breed disqualifications apply.

**\*\*Note: Italian Greyhounds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.\*\***

### **TESTS OFFERED:**

- **JUNIOR COURSER:** Open to all eligible sighthounds. A hound running alone  
shall receive a certification from a Judge on one date and a second certification  
from a different judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a 600 yard  
course with a minimum of (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with  
enthusiasm and without interruption.

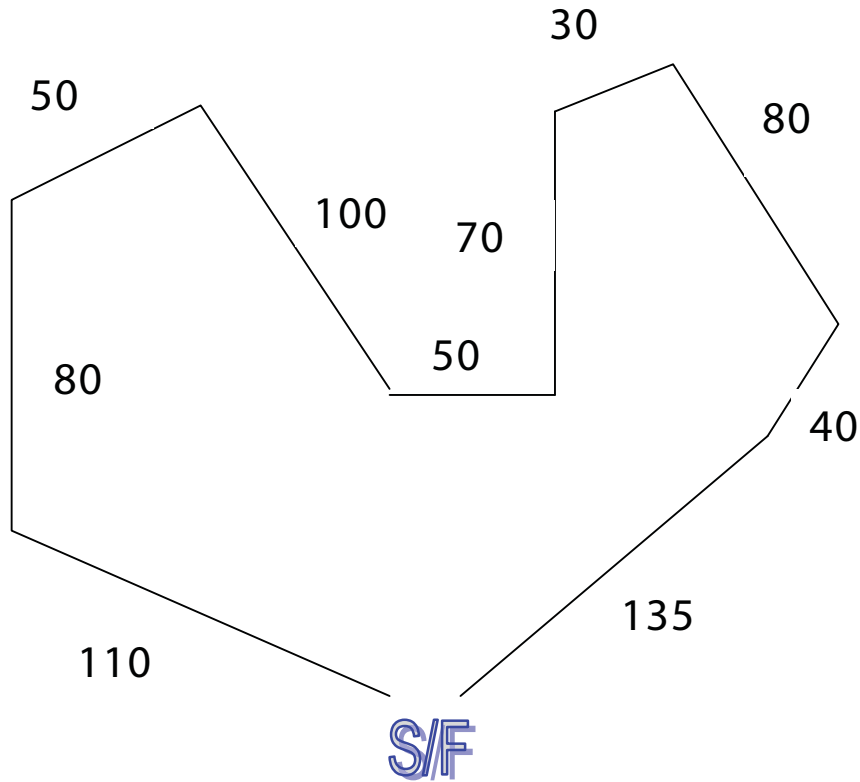
### **STAKES OFFERED:**

- **Open:** Open to all hounds of an eligible breed that have attained at least one of the  
following. AKC Junior Courser, ASFA Field Champion Title, CKC Field  
Champion Title, AKC Field Champion Title. Hounds that are disqualified or  
dismissed twice from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field trials may not be entered.
- **Open Veterans:** Open to all hounds of an eligible breed to enter Open or Specials  
stakes who meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's  
parent club. Championship points will be awarded.
- **Specials:** Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter the Open Stake and have  
earned their AKC Field Championship Title. Specials may compete for LCX  
points.
- **Best In Field Will be Offered:** All Best of Breed winners, with the exception of  
Italian Greyhound, shall be eligible to compete.

### **GENERAL:**

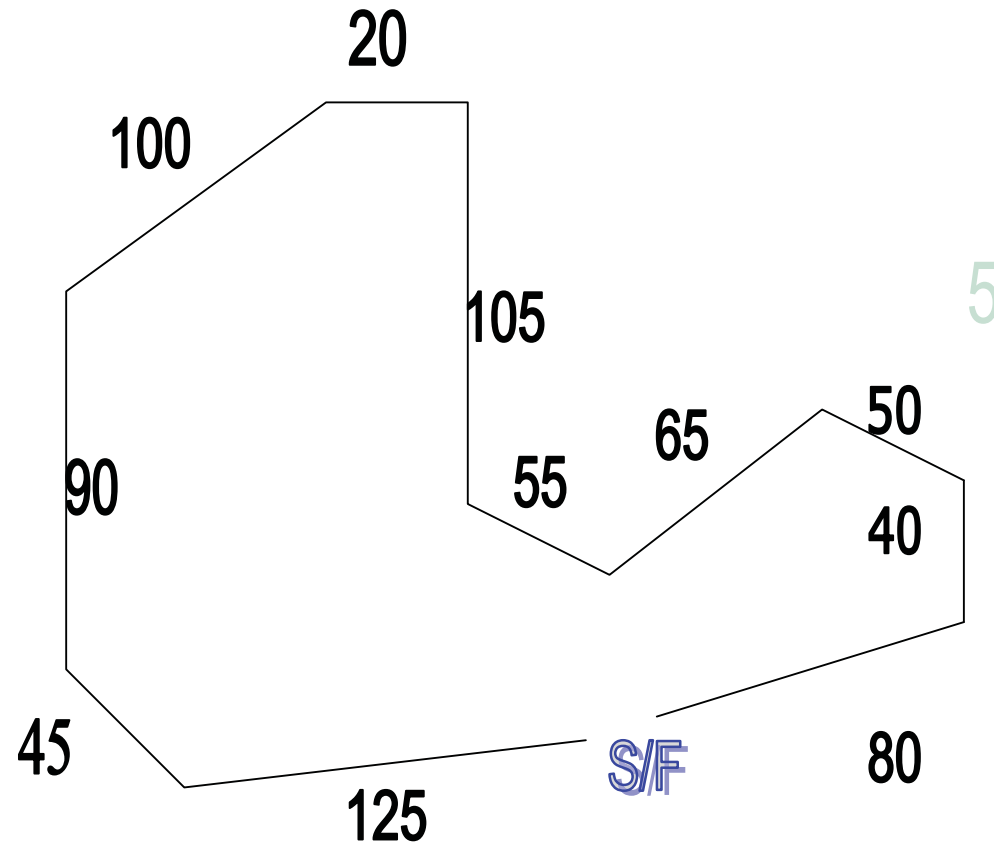
1. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces, unless excused,  
dismissed, or disqualified.
2. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5  
minute grace period.
3. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications.
4. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused.
5. Spayed or neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be  
entered.
6. Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. Back up  
equipment will be available. Lure will consist of white plastic bags.
7. The course will be reversed for finals and run-offs.
8. THERE WILL BE A \$5.00 FINE ASSESSED FOR ANY LOOSE  
HOUND NOT TAKING PART IN THE COURSE IN PROGRESS
9. PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN SHELTER, WATER, AND LUNCH.  
YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL YOUR OWN GARBAGE AND  
DOG WASTE.
10. THE FIELD COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO BAR  
KNOWN AGGRESSIVE HOUNDS FROM THE TRIAL SITE.

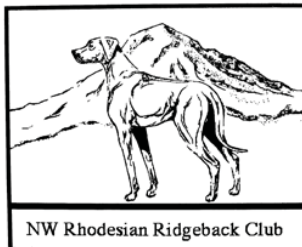
