

CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

- This is VERY ROUGH pastureland terrain with hills and rocks. It is **not** recommended for Italian Greyhounds.
- All hounds will be run in trios or braces, twice, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched, and their entry fee will NOT be refunded.
- All handlers MUST use a slip lead when releasing their hounds.
- Hounds may wear muzzles and/or catch collars at the owner/agent's discretion.
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused and will have their entry fee returned if notice is given to the secretary **prior** to roll call.
- The Chairman may excuse any hound from competition for any reason deemed justifiable.
- A \$5.00 fine, payable to ALCA, will be levied for any hound loose on the field at any time between roll call and the completion of Best in Field.
- There is NO shade or water available, so come PREPARED.
- Best in Field will be offered only on Sunday, July 11, 2010. Breed Winners from both Saturday and Sunday will be eligible to compete.
- You may camp overnight but, with the exception of a Port-a-Potty, there are no camping facilities.
- There will be a Steak BBQ after the end of the Trial on Saturday, July 10, 2010 at the Home of Ed and Ivy Molloy. Please advise us BEFORE the day of the Trial if you want to attend. Cost is \$5.00. Directions will be provided at the Trial. Location is about 15 minutes from the field.

EQUIPMENT AND FIELD CONDITIONS

An electric drag will be used for the Regular Classes and Singles.
A continuous loop may be used for the Puppy and Veteran stakes.
The field is pasture and park land with NO shade or water available.

Attention all Foreign Exhibitors!

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables foreign-born and foreign-owned dogs to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN mail or Fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with payment in the amount of \$58.65 Canadian funds, payable to the CKC. This ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event to avoid cancellation of Awards. DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD

The field is located east of Sherwood Park and 18 km east of Highway 21. Go east on Baseline Road (becomes Twp 530) to Range Road 211. Turn left, then first entrance on the left. From Highway 16, go right at Range Road 211, south to last driveway on the right before Twp 530. This is north of the Sherwood Park Freeway.

ELIGIBLE ENTRIES

To be eligible for this trial, your dog **MUST** be a purebred of one of these following breeds: AFGHAN, BASENJI, BORZOI, DEERHOUND (SCOTTISH), GREYHOUND, IBIZAN, IRISH WOLFHOUND, ITALIAN GREYHOUND, PHARAOH, SALUKI OR WHIPPET. All entrants must be registered or be eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club. Altered or neutered hounds **may** compete. Hounds presently disqualified under C.K.C., CSFA, ASFA or AKC rules are not eligible. **Hounds must pre-qualify prior to entering their first trial in Canada.**

CLASSES AND STAKES OFFERED

Lure Trial Official Classes

OPEN - Offered for all eligible hounds one year of age or older on the day of the trial, including Field Champions of Record.

Lure Trial Unofficial Classes

Best In Field Offered on Sunday only to include all Best of Breed winners from both Saturday and Sunday.

Singles	Offered on Saturday and Sunday.
Puppies (6-9, 9-12, 12-18 months)	Offered Saturday, after official classes
Veterans	Offered Saturday, after official classes
Kennel, Club and Breeder Stakes	Offered on Sunday.

Dogs not individually registered with the CKC are considered **Listed**. A Listing fee must accompany each entry for each Trial.

Payment in full must accompany all entries. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for any N.S.F. cheque. Overpayment of entries will be considered a donation to the Trophy Fund.

UNOFFICIAL CLASS SCHEDULE

Singles Competition

Is your dog DQ'd, declared ineligible or not ready for running in competition, but you would like your dog judged? This is the place to be! Dogs will be run individually and scored by both judges. Hounds will run after the Open stake has completed its preliminary round and then again after the Open stake has completed its final round. A random draw will determine the order of running of dogs in this stake. Dogs must wear a blanket. No points are awarded and all ties will be settled by a coin toss. A ribbon will be awarded to 1st to NBQ.

Puppies and Veterans, run singly (Saturday after completion of regular classes and any Certification runs).

Entry must be received by 11.30 a.m. Saturday, July 10, 2010.

Kennel, Club and Breeder Stakes

Entry must be received by 8.30 a.m. Sunday, July 11, 2010

FIRST TIME ENTERED HOUNDS

As of July 1st, 1998, all hounds competing for the first time must be certified prior to entry in a Field Trial. If this is the Hound's first Trial you must submit the Certificate to the Field Trial Secretary (3, 3.1.2 (a) CKC Field Trial Regulation).

CERTIFICATION RUNS

ALCA will hold Certification runs after the completion of the Regular Trial on Saturday and Sunday evening. Cost is \$10.00. If you would like to have a Certification run on the evening of Friday, July 9, 2010 please let us know in advance. You are expected to make your own arrangements for a suitable dog to run yours with.

CKC definition:

7.1.1 (a) A hound must be tested with another dog, not a kennelmate, preferably of the same breed, and certified running clean by a licensed judge. Hounds must be a minimum of 11 months old prior to being certified, and must run a normal course of 600 yards (548.4 m) in order to be certified..

ROLL CALL TIMES AND RUNNING ORDERS

Post Entry closes at 8.30 a.m. each day. Roll call will be at 9:00 a.m. each day.

Breeds will be run in alphabetical order on Saturday, and reverse alphabetical order on Sunday.

Puppy Stakes and Veterans will be run AFTER Official Classes on Saturday.

PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded to BOB, First through NBQ placements and BIF.

A Qualifying ribbon will be offered for each qualifying score earned by a hound which has not previously earned the Novice Courser Title.

A ribbon will be awarded to 1st to NBQ for the Singles run.

A ribbon will be offered for the winner of each of the Kennel, Breeder and Club stakes.

A Trophy is being offered by Norwick Kennel Reg'd for the Best in Field winner.

Extract from CKC Field Trial Rules and Regulations for Lure Coursing
Chapter 9.5 Placements and Awards

9.5.1 Hounds which are not to be scored are not to be added to a course.

9.5.2 Championship points in regular stakes shall be awarded on the basis of the following:

First Place:

Four times the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 40 points.

Second Place:

Three times the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 30 points.

Third Place:

Twice the number of hounds competing in the stake with a maximum of 20 points.

Fourth Place:

Points equal to the number of hounds competing in the stake to a maximum of 10 points.

Next Best Qualified Dog (NBQ):

No points awarded.

Qualifying Score (QS)

No points awarded.

9.5.3 A hound shall not receive a placement or be awarded points if it does not score at least 50 per cent of the total possible combined scores. Hounds which do not receive placements under this provision will, nevertheless, be considered as having been in competition for the purpose of awarding points. If a hound is excused in the preliminary run, that hound will not count as having been in competition when computing championship points. Hounds that are dismissed or declared ineligible shall count as having been in competition when computing championship points.

ATTENTION

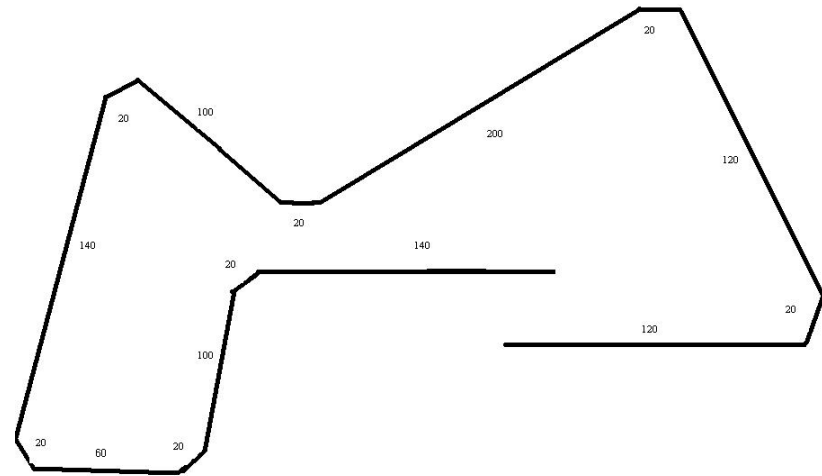
It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteers or any participant at the event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Courses subject to change depending on weather and safety considerations

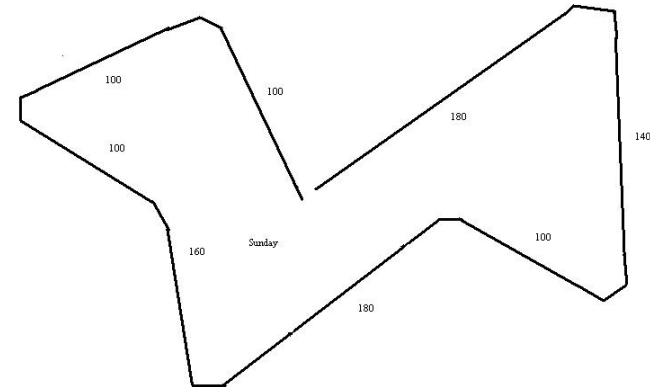
Saturday
