FIRST CLASS MAIL

Directions to the Site:

From the North: From I-5 take exit #127 (Hwy 512 Puyallup exit) toward Puyallup.

- Take the Pacific Ave. exit (Hwy 7) and turn right.
- Go South on Pacific Ave. approx. 5 miles to the Roy "Y" and bear right on WA-507/Spawaway McKenna Hwy.
- Go 1.2 miles and turn slight left onto 8th Ave. Continue another 5.2 miles.
- Just after crossing 288th St. (flashing yellow light), turn left into the entrance to the Polo Field on a dirt road marked with signage. Follow dirt road to field.

From the South: Take I-5 exit 88A (Tenino exit) and follow to Yelm.

- Turn right at the stop light and follow to McKenna.
- Turn right at the stop light in McKenna (Union 76) on Hwy 702/352nd St.
- Go 5.3 miles to the flashing yellow light and turn left on 8th Ave.
- Go approx. 3.5 miles. The Roy Polo Field is down a dirt road in the trees on the right, just before the 288th St. intersection (flashing yellow light), and will be marked with signage.
- Follow the entrance road, past the polo field on the right, to a second parking area near the big white house at the end of the road.

ELIGIBLE BREED AND REGISTRY

Only purebred Basenjis may be entered. All entries shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, the United Kennel Club, the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry. Dogs with an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or a Purebred Alternate Listing (PAL) from the American Kennel Club shall be considered registered with that body. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry.

REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

OPEN: Any eligible Basenji excluding ASFA Field Champions of record. All first-time entries must be accompanied by a signed Hound Certification form and copy of the registration certificate.

FIELD CHAMPION: Any ASFA Field Champion Basenji.

VETERAN: Any eligible Basenji whose age is at least 6 years. Points & placements go to a V-FCh. or V-LCM title. All first-time entries must be accompanied by a signed Hound Certification form and copy of the registration certificate.

SINGLE: Any eligible Basenji including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Basenjis run alone and are not eligible to run in Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED: The highest placing Basenji in each regular stake other than Singles will compete in an elimination course to determine Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

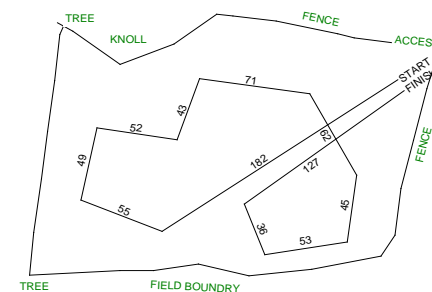
KENNEL STAKE: For Basenjis; an entry shall consist of two hounds, designated at time of entry, in one of the regular stakes being owned and kenneled by the same person.

BREEDER STAKE: For Basenjis, which shall have, designated at time of entry, two hounds bred by the same individual.

GENERAL

1. All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
2. Stakes shall be split by public random draw if the entry in any one stake is 20 or more.
3. In the Trial, all Basenjis will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified.
4. Basenjis not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused. Entry fees for Basenjis excused during inspection will be refunded. Spayed or neutered Basenjis without breed disqualifications may be entered.
5. **Certifications will be offered before the trial.**
6. Battery powered **continuous loop** machines will be used. Lure will consist of white plastic bags. The course will be reversed for the finals and run-offs. Backup equipment will be available.
7. The Field Committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
8. **THE FIELD COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO BAR KNOWN AGGRESSIVE BASENJIS FROM THE TRIAL SITE.**
9. **THERE WILL BE A \$5.00 FINE ASSESSED FOR ANY LOOSE BASENJI NOT TAKING PART IN THE COURSE IN PROGRESS, OR FOR ANYONE NOT PICKING UP AFTER THEIR OWN DOG(S). ALL TRASH, INCLUDING DOG FECES, MUST BE HAULED AWAY BY THE OWNER.**
10. **PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN SHADE AND WATER.**
11. **NO ONE, EXCEPT FIELD COMMITTEE, WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD WITHOUT EXPRESS PERMISSION OF THE FIELD CHAIRMAN.**
12. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be excused from the field for the day.
13. No cigarette smoking permitted on this working farm field.

Rule effective October 1, 1994: Ch. V, Sec. 4 (a) OPEN STAKE: *To be eligible to enter the open stake, a hound must have been certified by a licensed judge within the year preceding the closing date for the entry or have previously competed in the Open Stake.* This eligibility requirement also applies to a hound entered in the Limited or Veteran Stake, which has not competed in Open previously. Please complete the bottom half of this form and attach it to the entry form for the hound's first entry, including an entry for a Fun Trial.

Waiver of Requirement: *This requirement will be waived for a hound that has earned a lure coursing or racing title from another recognized organization, if such title requires competition, and if a waiver for such title has been approved by the ASFA, or a CKC Hound Certification Form.* If your hound qualifies for a waiver, complete the top half of this form and attach it to your entry form.
