

DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD:

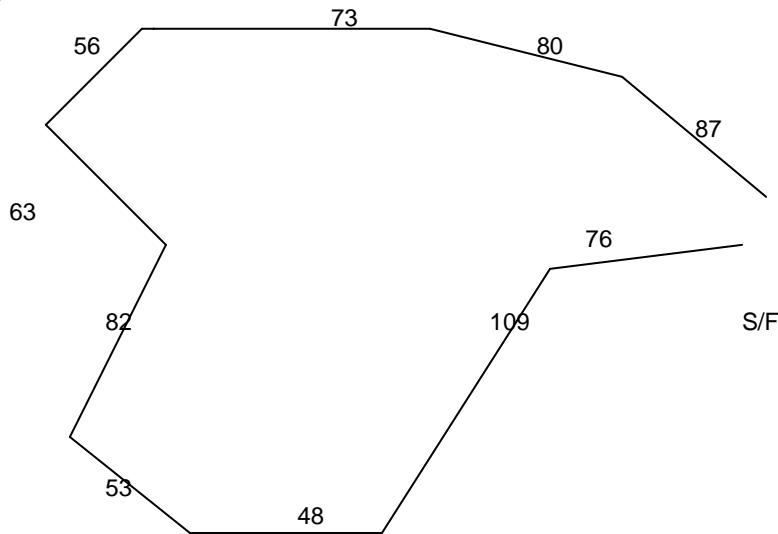
This is a large flat field.

From Vancouver: take Highway 1 East to Exit #135 (Highway 9 North to Agassiz). Follow signs to Agassiz. Pass through Agassiz following signs to Harrison Hot Springs, Mission, Vancouver. Turn right at the **second** traffic light. Go over the railway crossing bearing left (West). At the Junction of Highway 9 and 7 turn left onto the Lougheed Highway to Mission (Vancouver). After 1 mile turn right on Cameron Road at the Gas Station (closed). Humphrey Rd. is first on left. The field is at the north-west corner of the intersection.

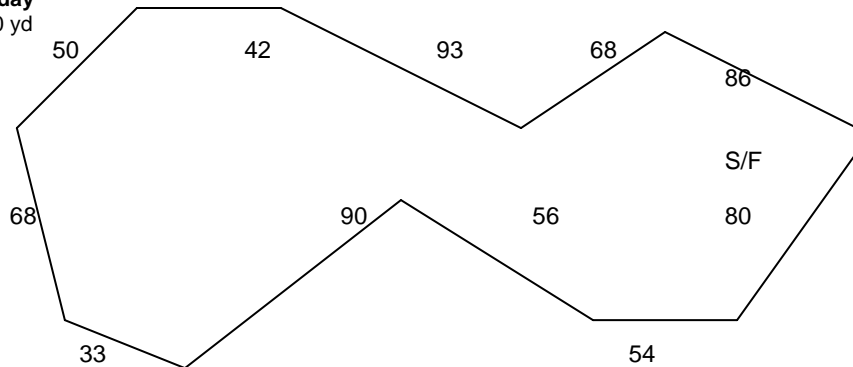
From the US: take Exit #256 in Bellingham and turn right at the light onto Meridian and follow the signs to the Sumas border crossing (north of Lynden). Stay on the road that crosses the border and you are on Hwy #11. About 2 miles north of the border crossing turn right (East) on Highway #1. Follow directions as above. It takes about 50 minutes from the border crossing to the field

COURSE PLANS: Please note: Drawings are not to scale and may be altered due to weather or field conditions.

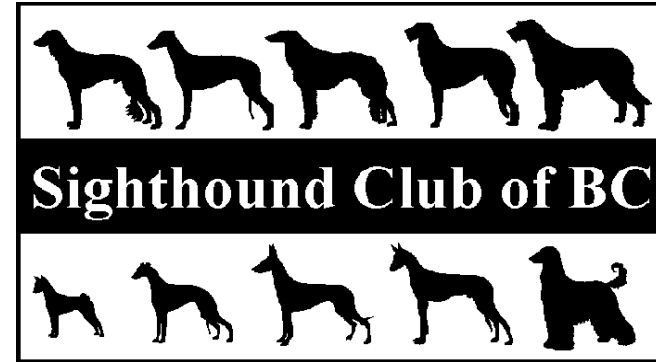

ELIGIBLE ENTRY: Field Trial

For any Afghan Hound, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Italian Greyhound, Irish Wolfhound, Pharaoh Hound, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound or Whippet that is one year of age or older on the date of the trial. All entrants must be registered with, or eligible for registration with, the Canadian Kennel Club. Hounds with breed disqualifications, altered or neutered are eligible. Hounds presently disqualified or declared ineligible under CKC, AKC or ASFA coursing rules are ineligible for the Open Stake, but are allowed to run in the Singles Stake.

STAKES :

Open all hounds, including Field Champions
Mixed for multiple breeds with entries of three or less, with the owners' agreement
Best in Field for all Best of Breed winners & 1st place Mixed Stake winners, both Sat and Sun. Run on Sunday only. **This stake is offered only by decision on the day by the Field Trial Committee.** At least two hounds must offer and hound sizes must be compatible in the judgement of the Committee.
Singles for any hound, at least 12 months old, not entered in the official trial. No championship points are awarded. Run individually, once, on a full course.
Puppies For any hound, 6 to 17 months, not entered in the official trial of the day. No points awarded. Run individually, once, shortened course.

EQUIPMENT: Battery powered drag line lure machine with white plastic streamers.

PRIZES: Rosettes will be offered for all field placements (inc Singles/Puppies). Prizes will be awarded to BOB winners, 1st in Mixed Stake and Best in Field. Flat ribbons are offered for Qualifying Scores.

FIELD TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS: Will be awarded as follows:

1st place - four times number competing to a maximum of 40 points.
2nd place - three times number competing to a maximum of 30 points.
3rd place - two times number competing to a maximum of 20 points.
4th place - one times the number competing to a maximum of 10 points.
NBQ - no points awarded.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Order of running: Sat/Sun reverse alphabetical.

Singles Stake (Sat/Sun); Puppy Stake (Sat/Sun).

Stakes will be split if the entry in any breed reaches 24 or more at Roll Call.

- **The owners of the field will not permit any competitor or spectator to bring a bitch in season onto the grounds. Please respect this for the sake of all entire males. Please check your bitches before leaving home. Entry fees for all your dogs will be refunded.**
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- Pre-entered bitches in season and lame hounds will have their entry refunded provided notice is given at or before Roll Call.
- Otherwise, hounds not present at Roll Call will be scratched and entry fee not refunded.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has happened.
- Only the 1st place winner of the Mixed Stake may compete in Best in Field.
- A \$5.00 fine will be levied against the owner of any hound loose on the field.
- For your comfort, please wear appropriate footwear.
- Overnight camping is permitted at the trial site on the southern portion of the field in front of the house.
- Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be asked to leave the trial site.
- A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada.
- A port-a-potty and a concession will be available at the field.
- Please properly dispose of trash (e.g. cig butts, dog poop), as this is an agricultural field.
- There will be a walking start. Do not release your dog before the 'T' in 'Tally-ho', else the dog may be assessed a penalty of between 1 and 10 points by each judge.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: (This does NOT apply to Singles entries.)

Effective July 1998, hounds entering their first trial in Canada must be tested with another dog, not a kennel mate, and certified running clean by a licensed judge. The CKC Hound Certification form must be completed and submitted with the entry at the hound's first trial. Hounds with the following are exempt; ASFA F.Ch. or LCM, AKC F.Ch., S.C. or D.C., but are still required to submit the Hound Certification form with their name and exempt title(s) circled.

ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS:

We will accept personal cheques, however they must be payable in US funds for the full amount of the entry. Cheques marked "payable in Canadian funds" are not readily cleared through the bank. Your co-operation is appreciated.
 US owned dogs may compete with an Event Registration Number. This number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. An ERN can be obtained by submitting a copy of your AKC registration with a letter of request to the CKC offices. Fee is \$52.50 (request may be faxed using VISA). **A \$8:40 listing fee is payable for each dog not showing a CKC/ERN registration number.**
